



An app should require only permissions that are related to the app's purpose.

Apps that require high privileges or admin consent are more likely to be risky.

Investigate user consents to the app in the activity log.

Investigate the app's name and publisher in different app stores. Focus on following apps, which might be suspicious:

- o Apps with a low number of downloads.
- o Apps with a low rating or score or bad comments.
- o Apps with a suspicious publisher or website.
- o Apps whose last update isn't recent. This might indicate an app that is no longer supported.
- o Apps that have irrelevant permissions. This might indicate that an app is risky.

If the reviewer is unable to determine if an application is safe then the Admin Consent team shall review.
